Fundraising Coordinator (Part time)

Ecosystem Restoration Camps is looking for a part time Fundraising Coordinator to work with our team to expand our funding base.

As a registered non profit, we rely on donations to support the development of new Ecosystem Restoration Camps, develop our open access knowledge base, match campers to campsites, maintain our communication channels, and the further development of our organisation.

Our aim is to maintain a small central staff and work with the people who form the Ecosystem Restoration Camps to carry out our work.

This role will involve:

- 1) Setting up a list of prospective institutional funders, setting up the initial contact, and coordinating the approach and funding-proposal process.
- 2) Develop the database of potential corporate partners as well as approaching them to see if a partnership is possible.
- 3) Working with Communications on setting up online (crowd)funding campaigns.

Ecosystem Restoration Camps is a growing grassroots movement of people from around the world who want to do something to reverse global land degradation and hence combat climate disruption, biodiversity loss, poverty and hunger.
